

The activities of Japanese Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies 2022/2023

The Japanese Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies (JSECS) consists of 297 members (including 3 supporting members). We are constantly promoting research networks among its members, disseminating the information on talks and events organized by each member, through website, SNS and other medias. Below is the summary of our activity in 2022/2023.

The 44th annual meeting was held online on 25th June 2022, because of the pandemic situation. Its program included two research presentations, a symposium “Jean-Jacques Rousseau as the question of interiority/exteriority: from the logic of “*sentiment*” to the politics of truth” with 5 speakers and a lecture concert “On the dance music of J.S. Bach: their historical-cultural background and practice”.

The new number of our annual journal, *The Annual Bulletin* (No. 37) was published on 25th June 2022. It contains the report of the 43rd annual meeting in 2021, research articles, books or exhibition reviews.
