Norwegian Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies, 2020-2021.

The Norwegian Society for Eighteenth-Century Studies organizes biannual national conferences. Our last conference was held on February 3-5, 2021. The theme was «Nature and the Natural in the Eighteenth Century» and the conference was organized by boardmembers from the University of Tromsø. Keynote addresses were held by Linda Andersson Burnett (University of Uppsala) and Dominik Collet (University of Oslo). 17 papers were presented in joint sessions. Due to Covid, the conference was held online, via Zoom, and attendance was open to everyone. Attendance was high and the conference was well recieved.
