

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ARRIVAL AND SHUTTLES

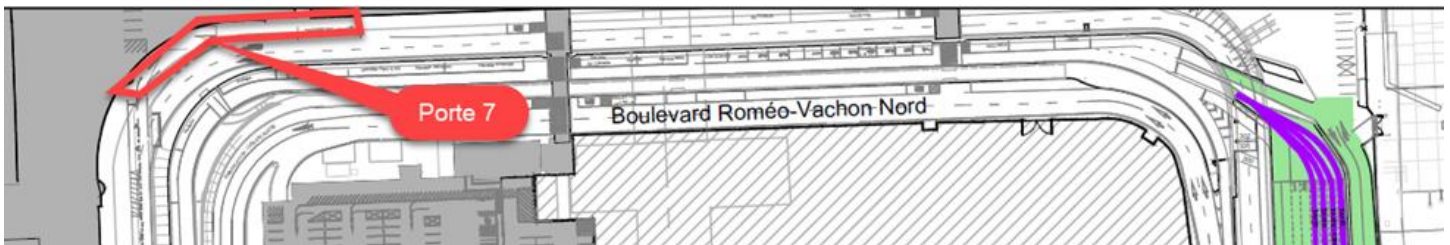
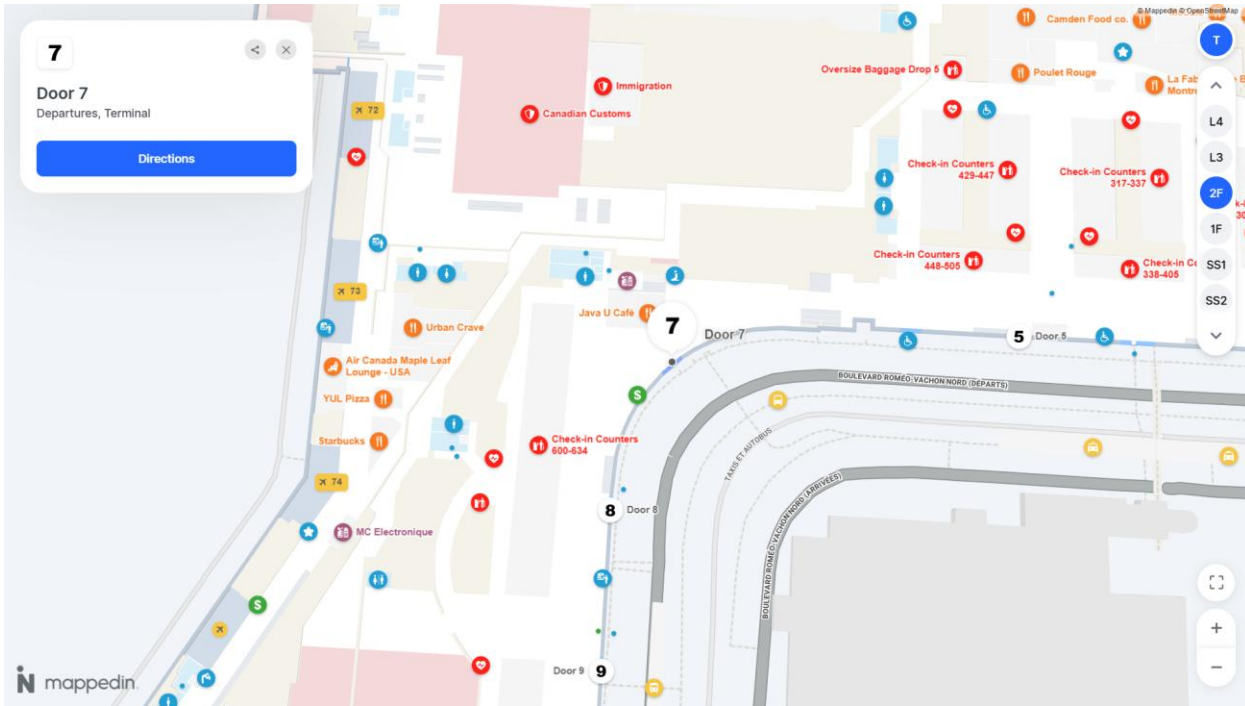
1. Montréal-Trudeau International Airport (YUL)

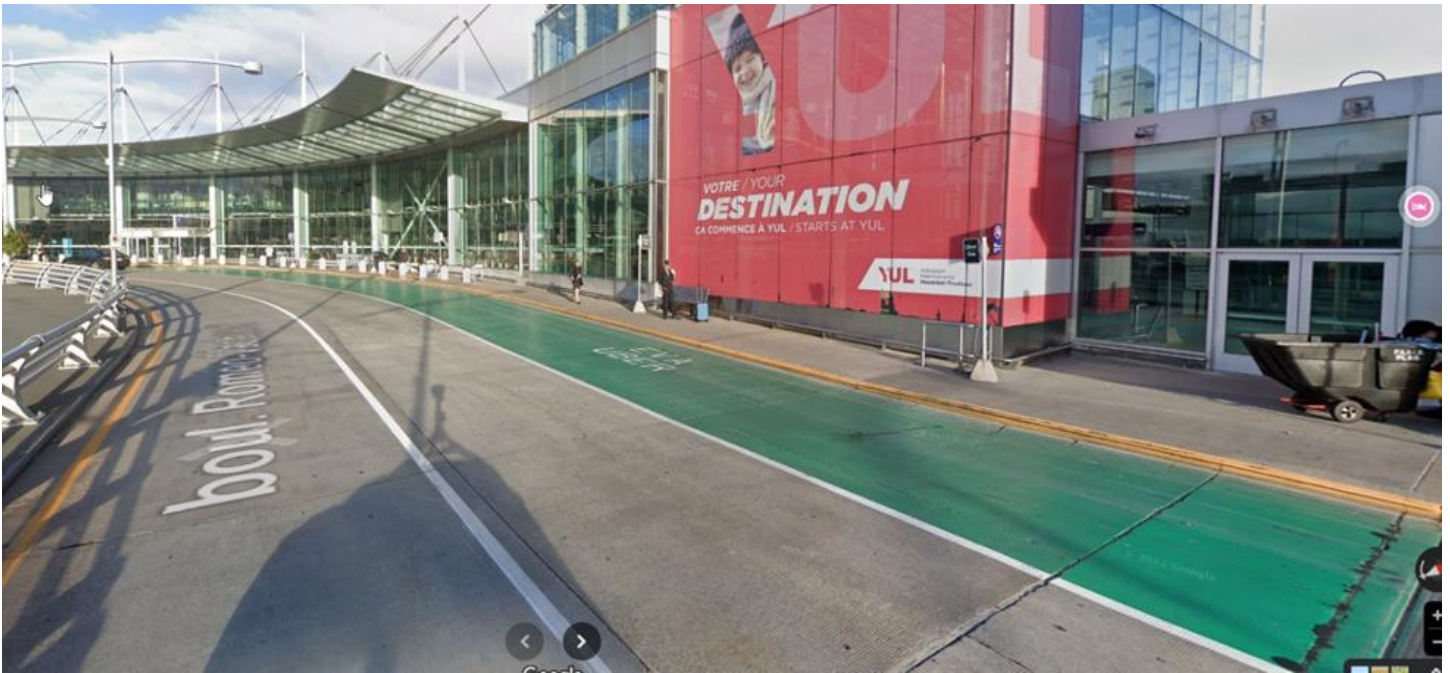
Upon clearing customs and collecting your luggage, please proceed to the designated shuttle zone.

a) Boarding Point: Door 7 (second floor, see the map below).

b) Directions: Follow the signs for “Ground Transportation” and “Hotel Shuttles.” Door 7 is located on floor 2, on boul. Roméo-Dallaire.

c) Arrival Map:





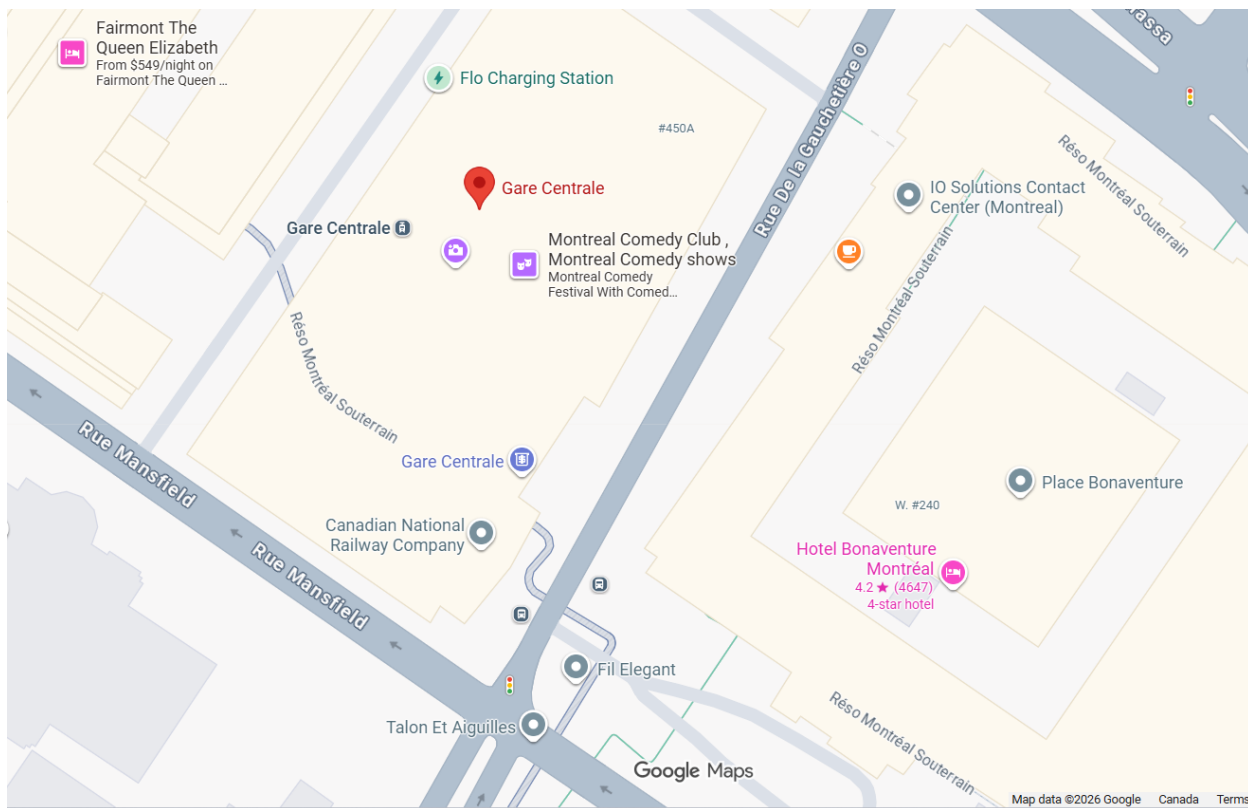
2. Montréal Central Station (Gare Centrale)

For those arriving by train or by bus, the shuttle will be waiting outside the main station complex.

a) Boarding Point: De la Gauchetière Street Entrance.

b) Directions: Upon exiting on De la Gauchetière Street, volunteers will be waiting to guide you towards the shuttle, which will be parked at the designated passenger pickup curb along this street.
